ENEL GREEN POWER, IS AWARDED WITH 193 MW IN THE BRAZILIAN PUBLIC AUCTION FOR NEW ENERGY

- Enel Green Power, has been awarded with 3 highly efficient wind farm projects located in the Brazilian States of Rio Grande do Norte, Pernambuco and Bahia.
- These projects will add 193 MW to Enel Green Power's 90 MW of wind projects that were awarded last year and 93 MW of hydro capacity already in operation in Brazil.
- Enel Green Power's successful participation in the 2011 Brazilian New Energy Auction is a significant step forward in the deployment of its growth strategy in Latin America

Rome, August 19th 2011 – Enel Green Power has been awarded power supply contracts with three wind projects totaling 193 MW of installed capacity in the 2011 Brazilian New Energy Auction. These projects are located in the Northeast of Brazil in the States of Bahia, Pernambuco and Rio Grande do Norte, the latter in consortium with Endesa.

Commercial operations of these projects is expected by 2014.

These three wind farms will be able to generate as much as 770 GWh per year, enough to serve as many as 500,000 households in Brazil and are aimed at meeting the growing Brazilian power demand which is estimated to grow at an annual rate of approximately 5%.

The wind projects of Enel Green Power have outstanding capacity factors over 45% or approximately 4,000 hours per year in power generation.

Through this auction Enel Green Power has been granted the right to sell defined energy volumes from its wind farms to a pool of regulated distribution companies with 20 years power supply contracts. Additional energy volumes will be sold to the liberalized market through long term pre-established commitments.

The estimated total investment for the three projects is approximately 330 million euros.

"This is an important step forward in our strategy to develop high quality projects in a fast growing and competitive market environment as the Brazilian one" - commented Francesco Starace, CEO and General Manager of Enel Green Power - "We see excellent conditions for a sustainable and large development of renewables in Brazil and, in this context, EGP will be able to play an important role, making the most of its technologies while leveraging on the strong synergies it has with the Endesa group, operating on the Brazilian power market."
